## CELLAR COLLECTION - RED WINE

214 Amarone della Valpolicella 2018 Tenute Dal Cero Veneto, Italy £98  
*Complex dark fruits, plum, fig, black cherry and cocoa, rich and full in the mouth, intense concentrated dark fruit flavours, a hint of spice and long lingering finish.*

216 Shiraz 2022, Ebenezer Eisenstone, Barossa Valley, Australia £135  
*Intense & powerful yet with such finesse & poise, very small production, each bottle numbered, blueberry & blackberry, oak notes, grippy tannins give structure, complex animal of a wine.*

218 Gevrey Chambertin 2023 'Clos Village' Philippe Livera, Burgundy, France £210  
*Serious quality from the famous appellation Cotes de Nuits. Silky, smooth yet powerful glass of wine. Summer fruit combined with a savoury edge and the classic 'fruits of the forest' brambly character.*

215 Chateau de Valois 2020, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France £120  
*The nose bursting with black berries, exotic spice & hints of smoky oak & cedar. On the palate, the texture is rich & generous, with soft tannins. The finish has good freshness & full of lingering ripe fruit.*

217 Barolo Riserva 2019, 'San Giovanni' Broccardo, Piedmonte, Italy £150  
*Single Vineyard Barolo, the King of Kings! Red fruit, berries, spice, bramble and truffle, balanced by smooth tannins and a long elegant finish, complex and rewarding.*

219 Pommard 1er Cru 2022 'Clos de Epeneaux' Domaine du Comte Armand, Burgundy, France £350  
*Deep dark fruit on the nose - slight graphite note. Firm strike on the palate. It is both dense and elegant, for it has a lithe energy and shape. It's deep, but not full bodied. It's fresh. There are notes of cocoa powder. It's powerful, but sophisticated on the finish.*
